Service Hours and Planning Guide

The service packages below are a guide to hours for each service and are intended to support Care Partner budgeting and planning. Actual timeframes may vary based on participant needs, goals, living situation, and complexity.

Assessment and Billing Information

- **Standard Allocation**

All Occupational Therapy assessments are allocated 2.5 hours.

- **Transparent Billing**

If the full time is not required, only the actual hours used will be billed.

- **Proactive Planning**

The Occupational Therapist will contact the Care Partner before the initial assessment to discuss needs. If extra time is anticipated, they will offer an upfront approval option to streamline care and potentially reduce the total number of visits.

- **Next Steps**

Following the assessment, the Occupational Therapist will discuss any additional service hours directly with the Care Partner.

- Assessment, trial, and prescription of 'under advice' AT items - Trials conducted at home or a showroom based on participant needs

Delivery	1.5 hrs
Covers 1x prescribed AT item Note: Additional AT items will require extra time	

4. Minor Mods + AT (Prescribed)	8 hours
Initial Assessment	2.5 hrs
Intervention	1 hr
AT Trial	2.5 hrs
Delivery & Review	2 hrs
Combines minor modifications with 1x prescribed AT item	

5. Powered Mobility	11.5 hours
Initial Assessment	2.5 hrs
Intervention	1 hr
Showroom Trial	3 hrs
Community Trial	3 hrs
AT Delivery	2 hrs
Full PoMoDATT Standardised Assessment process	

6. Major Modifications	~9 hours
Initial Assessment	2.5 hrs
Measurements	0.5 hrs
Builder Consult	3 hrs
Liaison	1 hr
Post-Completion Review	2 hrs
Full builder consult pathway. A 2nd consult may be required if multiple quotes are needed
